Part 1 - Exotic Wood Species I usually stock.

These exotic wood species are subject to availability with some no longer allowed for export from their source country so supplied many become limited or non-existent in the future. Other exotic species are available, see the Wall Lumber site, but may result in a higher cost due to the need of ordering just a small amount of a species I don't stock.

Part 2 - Common American Hardwoods I stock.

I always have American Walnut, Cherry and Red Oak in stock. These woods are perhaps 40 to 50% less than the exotic woods. So the cost for a Lazy Susan turntable would be a little less. But much of the cost is in the labor so the cost reduction is modest.

Note: American Red Oak is the only hardwood that I would consider applying stain to.

Besides the natural, fairly light color, of Red Oak there are many stains available. I usually use MinWax stains as they have repair stick available for most of their popular stains.
